Newsletter Editor – Responsible for producing the Space Coast Ski Club's newsletter, The Snowbird,

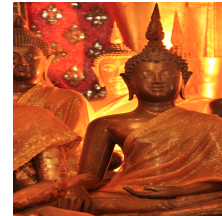
